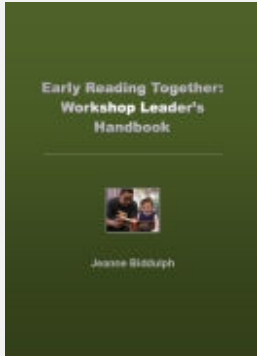

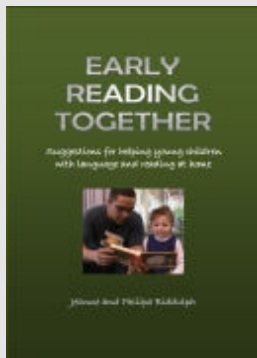

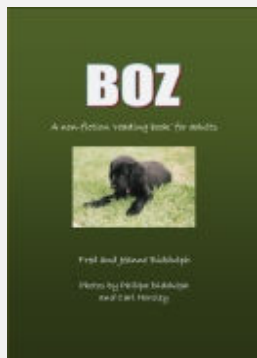
### 1. Early Reading Together: Workshop Leader's Handbook

- This handbook is intended for use by early childhood educators, junior school teachers and children's librarians who are interested in implementing the *Early Reading Together* programme for groups of parents and caregivers whose children are at home, in early childhood centres, and in the first year of primary school.



### 2. Early Reading Together: Suggestions for helping young children with language and reading at home

- This booklet for parents contains suggestions for enhancing children's language and literacy learning at home.
- Although the booklet may be used by early childhood educators, teachers, librarians and parents in New Zealand as a 'stand-alone' resource, the suggestions have been shown to be much more meaningful and helpful to parents and children when they are discussed, demonstrated and practised during the workshop programme described in the *Workshop Leader's Handbook*.
